"It Was Hot in Philadelphia"

It was hot in Philadelphia in the summer of '76 - 1776 - that is. The Continental Congress was meeting, arguing, sweating. John Adams kept urging a vote for independence, others favored the status quo ("come weal or come woe, my status is quo"). The musical, "1776" has some fun lyrics about this: "It's hot in Philadelphia! Someone ought to open up a window! No, no no! Too many flies! Sit down John! It's 90 degrees! Have mercy John! I say vote yes! John, you're a bore; we've heard this before, now sit down John!"

Despite the heat, the flies, the interminable chatter of John Adams — and the others — the Continental Congress did get around to voting for independence. Fifty-six representatives signed the document.

The date of July 4 has been etched in the minds of U.S. citizens ever since. It has had a remarkable history. Consider that on the 50th anniversary of that signing, July 4, 1826, both John Adams and Thomas Jefferson, our 2nd and 3rd presidents, died. Adams' last words were, "Jefferson survives," but it was not true, Jefferson had died that morning. Five years later, in late June, our 4th president, James Madison, was seriously ill. His friends considered what they might do to keep him alive until the 4th, but Madison would have none of their schemes. He died on the 28th of June, 1831.

President number five, however, James Monroe, accommodated all those who think dates matter. He died on the 60th anniversary of the signing of "Independency," July 4[,] 1836. That ended the sequence of presidential deaths on the Fourth of July. However, there were other



significant happenings associated with the date. Stephen Foster, who wrote many patriotic songs, as well as pieces supporting the presidential candidacies of both James Buchanan and Abraham Lincoln (from opposite parties, but sometimes you just have to make a buck!), was born July 4, 1826, and our 30th president, John Calvin Coolidge, was born July 4, 1872.

Finally, during the Civil War, the decisive Battle of Gettysburg took place July 2 and 3, with thousands from both sides wounded and dying. The victory went to the North but on the next day, the 4th of July, 1863, there wasn't much celebrating as poachers and robbers arrived to steal what they could from the bodies still lying on the battlefield: rings, wallets, belts, notebooks, it was all fair-game. A 4th unlike any other 4th. Four-score and seven years had passed since that famous hot day in Philadelphia and we were still attempting to discover if we were a "united" states.


